## [Schnapps fountain trail]

A hike with savory delights

🕒 2,5 h 📏 7 km 🏔️ 270 hm

The region counts more than 10 schnapps fountains, all situated near lovely lookout points along a northern and a southern signposted path. Delicious homemade schnapps, liqueur and cider pour from the picturesque fountains, as well as non-alcoholic beverages. For a small contribution, hikers can savor a drink and then continue their walk refreshed and invigorated.



## [Alde Gott panorama tour]

A hike for nature lovers

🕒 4-5 h 📏 10 km 🏔️ 639 hm

The panorama tour around the lovely floral and wine town of Sasbachwalden takes hikers through a wonderful natural and cultural landscape at the edge of the Black Forest. Vineyards, meadows, waterfalls and forests offer a pleasurable variety of sceneries that surprise and delight the beholder. There are many refreshment stops along the way.



## [Gaishöhl waterfalls]

Scenic trail to Hördenberg

🕒 2,0 h 📏 5 km 🏔️ 230 hm

The scenic circuit beginning at the health resort „Zum Alte Gott“ is one of the most popular hiking tours in the region. The forest path leading to the top of the waterfalls includes more than 13 wooden bridges and 225 steps, with an elevation difference of 200 meters. The cascades splash down into a narrow rocky gorge. Another must-see is the Straubenhöf-mühle mill dating from 1789.
